LGB Christians Report 2024-5

“I am enamoured with your vision”

“I recently stumbled upon your website and have since read most of the blogs, and become enamoured with your mission. I am a 16 year old lesbian and it is comforting to read about people who share the same views about infringement on the rights of the lesbian and gay community. I, like many others, find it so hard to get involved in most of the "inclusive" spaces because of fundamentally opposing views, especially because I am young.” Name supplied.

Our second year saw **LGB Christians** expand its outreach, increase the number of supporters, and our income. Alongside other new LGB national organisations created in the last 5 years we are part of a resurgent global movement affirming same-sex attraction.

We welcomed the Cass Review (The Independent Review of Gender Identity Services for Children and Young People), and the Supreme Court decision in the For Women Scotland case.

We are highly critical that the Church of England, and other Churches, have not fully embraced the Cass Review main findings, nor those of the Supreme Court. History will not be kind to Christianity as a result. The leadership of all these Churches are defaulting on the duty to the truth.

Our priorities remain:

- **consulting** interested parties by offering our knowledge and goodwill
- **creating** a dynamic, flexible database to enable maximum impact
- **building** a stimulating website with a cohort of established and new writers. As the only Christian gender-critical website it has a unique and increasingly important role. This year we published for the first time **Cathy Mudge, Dr Carole Sherwood, Gillian Philip and Benjamin Morse**. The site has established a reputation for attracting seminal thinkers and authoritative book reviewers. We began a series of interviews conducted by Benjamin Morse (historian Diarmaid MacCulloch) and Mark Chater (author Michael Arditti).
- **widening** our presence on social media
- **spreading** the word and responding to enquiries
- **encouraging** volunteers to help participate in our growing range of activities

We held our second in person social networking event in July 2024 at St Mary Magdalene's church, Paddington, North London hosted by Revd Natasha Woodward. We attended the 4th LGB Alliance conference at the QE11 Centre in Westminster in October 2024 at which Richard Kirker, representing LGB Christians was interviewed.

In September 2024 we were represented at the Genspect *Reframing the Future* conference in Lisbon.

We held a successful Christmas Party, promoted through Eventbrite, at St Luke's Church, Battersea where Revd Lorenzo Fernandez-Smal is vicar.

In January 2025 we attended and had a stall at the Human Gay Male conference in London.

We attracted media interest with a notable example being coverage in the Sunday Telegraph on 15th February 2025 with [the article](#) "Church covers altar with trans-inclusive pride flag 'in contravention of canon law'"

We created a WhatsApp group for particularly engaged supporters, i.e. those who had done one or more of the following: made a donation, attended an event, followed us on X (Twitter) and Liked/Shared/commented positively.

We created [merchandise](#) to help with funding: t-shirts, mugs, and a badge.

We ran a 6 week on-line advertising campaign with the Church Times

We made direct contact with Christian networks whose work is of related interest to find common ground. Generally we received a hostile response making it hard to break down barriers of antipathy, rejection, misrepresentation, or suspicion. We remain committed to creating dialogue wherever possible and will pursue all avenues to avoid being excluded by so-called 'inclusive' Christian groups.

A free E-Newsletter was published regularly and ten have been published. All previous editions [are available](#).

Fundraising remains our most serious challenge. All our work is undertaken at minimal cost but to a high standard. Some of this requires specialised and paid expertise, alongside invaluable contributions from volunteers.

We opened a UK registered bank account, Lloyds, using a full-service account for the first time and enabling donations to be made cost free to **LGC Christians** by bank to bank transfer. This has increased donation income but must be increased further.
